You would also assist with the delivery of content and act as an advisor for the Directed Foodservice Study course.

The **Instructor of Applied Degree in Culinary Operations** will be responsible to: develop and implement curriculum to meet industry standards, ensure the efficient delivery of the program using a variety of delivery methods, provide academic and skills counselling, comply with Occupational Health and Safety regulations, assess and provide feedback to learners, arrange and monitor internship/OJT placements, and establish and foster relations with industry and the advisory committee. You will also be required to participate in course research initiatives and to provide support to learners with their research projects, be proactive in initiating improvements/revenue generating opportunities, and assist with setting strategic and operational plans.

Qualifications: Candidates must possess: a Culinary Arts Diploma, Red Seal certification in the field and a minimum of five-years occupational expertise (managerial/supervisory) in the food services industry along with relevant credentials at the graduate (Masters or Doctorate) level. Consideration will be given to individuals who are currently enrolled in a Masters program and who meet the above experience/certification requirements. Candidates must have prior research experience and have strong interpersonal/organizational skills and have a reputation for building positive working relationships. Prior teaching experience will be considered an asset.
