Holland College is initiating an **Iron Worker Program** and is seeking a highly organized and detail –orientated learning manager/instructor to lead the development and instruct in this new program. This term position commences October 4, 2010 to May 20, 2011 and is located at our Georgetown Centre.

The successful candidate will ensure the efficient development and delivery of this program in the areas of blueprint reading; erect and install scaffolding, construction cranes, derricks and other hoisting equipment; assemble rigging to move heavy equipment and materials; assemble and erect pre-fabricated metal structures and select, cut, bend, position and secure steel bars or wire mesh in concrete forms. Other responsibilities include developing and updating of curriculum; evaluating and monitoring students' progress; complying with Occupational Health and Safety regulations; establishing and monitoring on the job training sites; providing maintenance of shop area and program equipment; administering budgets and maintaining liaison with industry.
